



Corporate 4 Ball Challenge Description

The CyrusOne Corporate Fourball Challenge is an invitational event designed to celebrate the competitive corporate culture in Chicago and across the Midwest.

From the many industries in the Chicagoland and the Midwest, this invitational will pit each company's "best" golfers against each other in the most competitive team play in golf, the Fourball Format. Each team will battle it out for the title of "**CyrusOne Corporate Fourball Champions**" along with the 2' gold plated inscribed trophy, prizes, framed photos of the Champions in the CyrusOne Aurora II lobby and most importantly, the bragging rights that come with it.

A true test of a golfer's skill; the event will be held at Cog Hill's No. 4 "The Patriarch of Public Golf" where players like Tiger, Dustin Johnson, Justin Rose, Jim Furyk, and Ben Crenshaw have all raised trophies. Also known as "**DUBDSDREAD**", its nickname derived from the idea that a "dub" or poor golfer should beware and served as a warning of the challenges that are forthcoming. So beware and bring your best to see if your company is good enough to bring home the inaugural trophy and "dubbed" the best in the Midwest!

Format:

Fourball is a playing format in the game of golf. It is also known as best ball or more properly better ball.

Competitors are paired and play as a team. Each golfer plays his own ball; the team's score on each hole is the lower of the two players' scores. Only one of a pair is required to complete each hole. The winners are the team with the lowest aggregate score over 18 holes. Since 2017 this format, along with foursomes, has been used by the Zurich Classic on the PGA Tour.
