About Us:

Midtown-Metro operates through its Metro Achievement Center for girls and Midtown Achievement Center for boys in grades 3 – 12. Programs focus on Hispanic and African American youth, offering after-school and summertime growth opportunities that help students of average academic ability to achieve above-average results. Programs are rooted in Catholic moral and social teaching and embrace students regardless of their religious, racial, ethnic, or familial status. Midtown-Metro received its original inspiration from Opus Dei, an institution of the Catholic Church, and continues today its partnership with Opus Dei

The Role:

- The Science Teacher at Midtown's summer program will cultivate a passion for science and critical thinking among 6th-8th-grade students (mornings) and/or 3rd-5th-grade students (afternoons)
- The Teacher will design and develop a curriculum emphasizing core scientific principles tailored to the needs and interests of the students.
- Leading three to four 45-minute classes daily, each accommodating roughly fifteen to twenty boys, the Teacher will create engaging and interactive lessons.
- The Teacher will receive support in the classroom from students' Advisors (mentors) assigned to each group.
- Assessing students' knowledge at the program's start and conclusion with a pre and post test will allow the Teacher to tailor instruction and measure growth.

Qualifications:

- Previous teaching experience, particularly with elementary or middle school students, is advantageous. One year of teaching experience is preferred.
- Bachelor's degree in Science or related field
- Strong knowledge of science curriculum, instructional practices, and assessment strategies

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to engage and connect with students of diverse backgrounds.
