Parents and children alike are enriched by its racial and socioeconomic diversity and consistent belief that each individual is a very important person worthy of dignity and respect.

HOW IT WORKS

- Each child receives up to 120 hours of tutoring/mentoring help throughout the school year for as little as \$2 an hour. Staff and instructors guide students through test prep classes. They also counsel parents on the high school and college selection process.
- In addition to academic support, students also benefit from virtue-based mentoring and character development classes where they grow in confidence, perseverance, and integrity.
- Nearly 75% of parents/guardians typically attend at least one parent session per semester.
 Many take full advantage of weekly sessions, an annual parenting conference that attracts more than 100 guests, and special events like Mother/Daughter Day at Metro and a Father/Son mixer at Midtown.
- 10% of the 300 annual volunteers at Metro and Midtown are alumni who return as tutors or guest lecturers. They have succeeded at becoming competent professionals, responsible citizens and, often times, parents who want to be positive role models for their children.
